At the Curb we accept cardboard, mixed paper, plastic, glass, food cans and aluminum cans. If you bag the recycling it needs to be in bags that we can see through so we can determine what the material is. Since we do use two trucks if we don't see recycling bags or clearly marked bags we will continue on and leave it for trash.

Blinds, metal, oil, tv's, computers, Styrofoam, egg Styrofoam cartons, paper plates, cups, forks spoons and knives and more are not recyclable and will get the bag thrown in the trash.

1. Recyclables, MSW, and C&D: Please make sure all of these materials brought to us are generated in Henderson County because we are not a regional facility

Spot Checking: Please ask drivers to spot check and remove MSW, C & D, and Electronics from single stream recycling from each load. These items have been found in a lot of incoming loads.
