

FY 16 Approved Budget Ordinance and Fee Schedule

The FY 16 Budget Ordinance and Fee Schedule was adopted by the Henderson County Board of Commissioners on June 2, 2015. All subsequent fees are effective July 1, 2015.

NC Banned Landfill Items

The following items have been banned by the NC Legislature from entering landfills across the state, but the majority of items can be recycled at the Transfer Station or Convenience Center:

- Used oil
- Yard trash (with exceptions)
- White goods
- Antifreeze
- Aluminum cans
- Whole scrap tires
- Lead acid batteries
- Beverage containers
- Oyster shells
- Motor vehicle oil filters
- Recyclable rigid plastic containers
- Wooden Pallets
- Discarded computer equipment and televisions
- Mercury-containing products, thermostats
- Fluorescent lights
- Hazardous waste

The following items must be taken to the Transfer Station for recycling:

- **TVs and monitors:**
 - ◆ \$10 per item*
 - ◆ all other household electronics must go to the Convenience Center (no charge)
- **Liquid paint & paint-related items:** \$2 per gallon container (no charge for spray paint)
 - ◆ 3rd Tuesday monthly
 - ◆ 8am until 2pm
 - ◆ 30 gallon per individual per event limit
 - ◆ see a full list of acceptable items at www.hcrecycles.org

* Fee goes into effect July 1, 2015

Many of the items in the list above can be recycled by residents at the Convenience Center daily. This includes recycling of waste oils, white goods, batteries, small household electronics, and mercury products (including thermostats and fluorescent bulbs). Other special recycling or disposal programs exist for households during specified times throughout the year. This includes events like the annual household hazardous waste (HHW) collection program.
